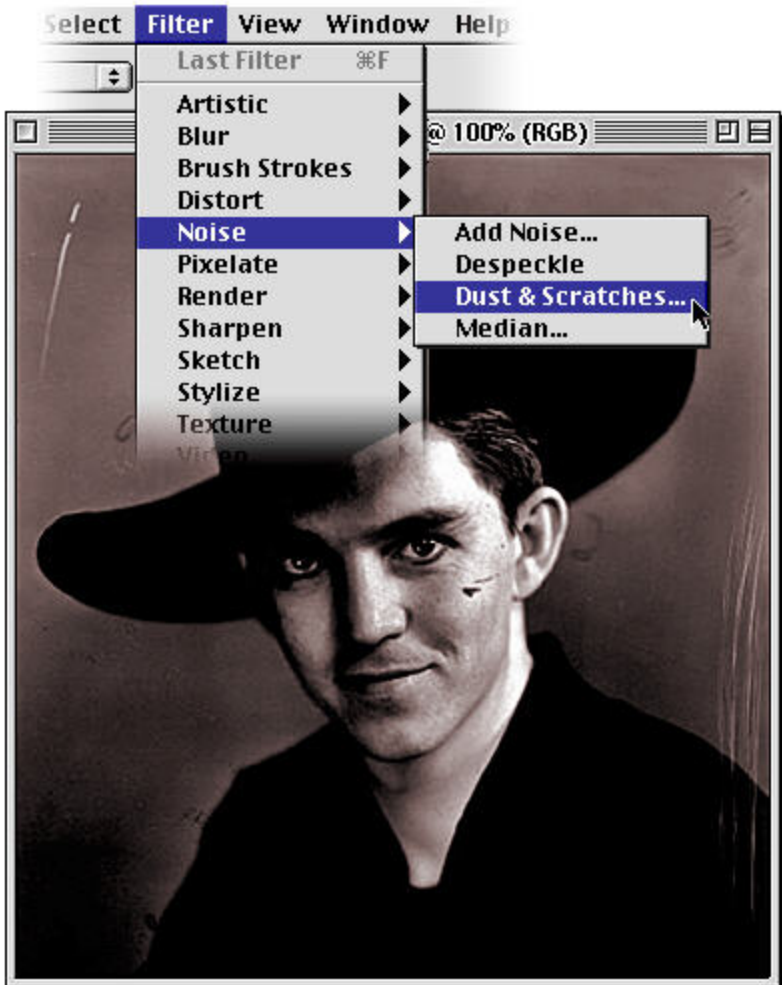


# Cleaning an Image



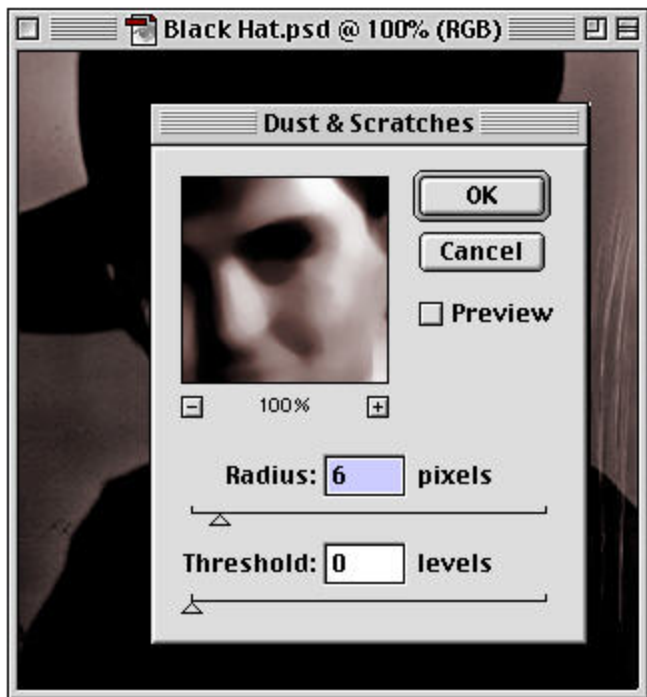
## Step 1:

The dust and scratches on this old photo take away from the overall image. Using a Wacom pen and Photoshop, here's how we cleaned-up this image.



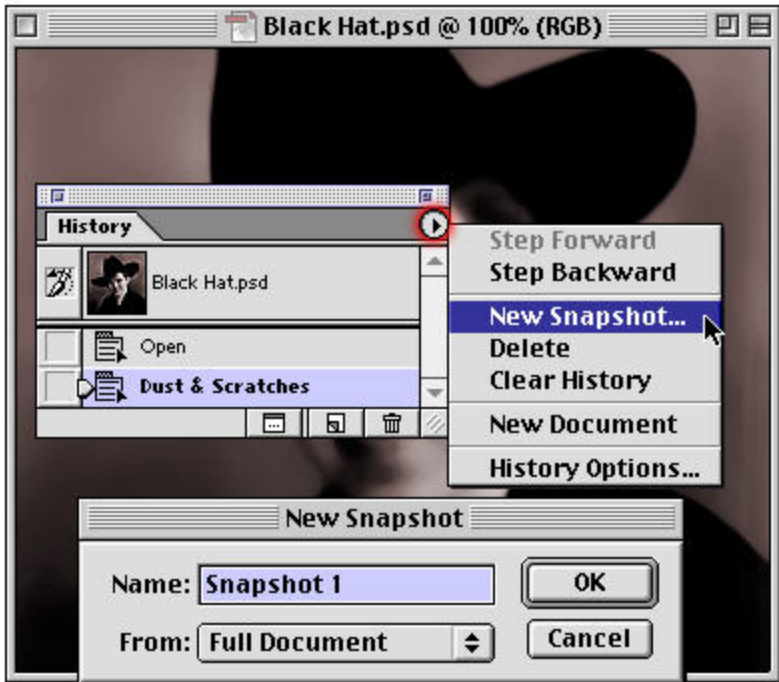
**Step 2:**

First, we chose the Dust & Scratches filter and referenced a large scratch on the man's cheek.



**Step 3:**

We chose a radius of 6 pixels which equaled the radius of the scratch and hit OK.



#### Step 4:

This produced a blurred image without any scratches. Then we clicked on the arrow above the History palette to take a snapshot of the original photo for future reference.



### Step 5:

We clicked on the original photo and set the Source to Snapshot 1 by tapping on the box to the left of the Snapshot icon. Then we used our Wacom pen to paint gently over the scratch with the History brush.



**Step 6:**

And here's our final photo without dust or scratches.
